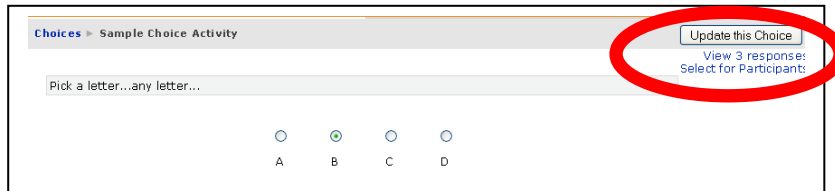


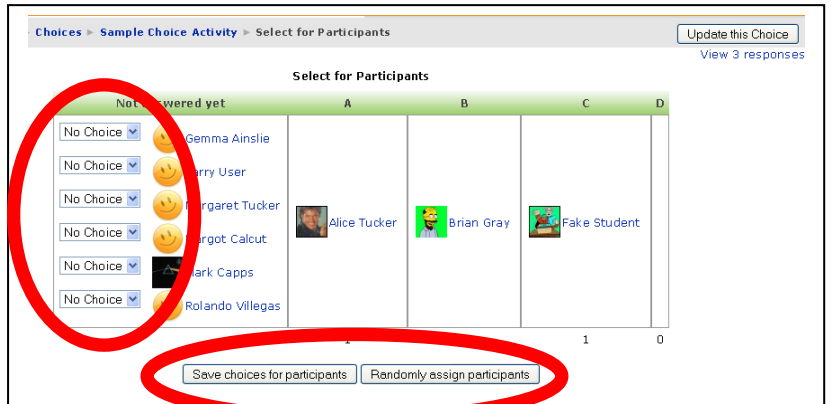
The “Select for Participants” option in the Choice Activity

A new link appears for authorized participants:
Select for Participants.

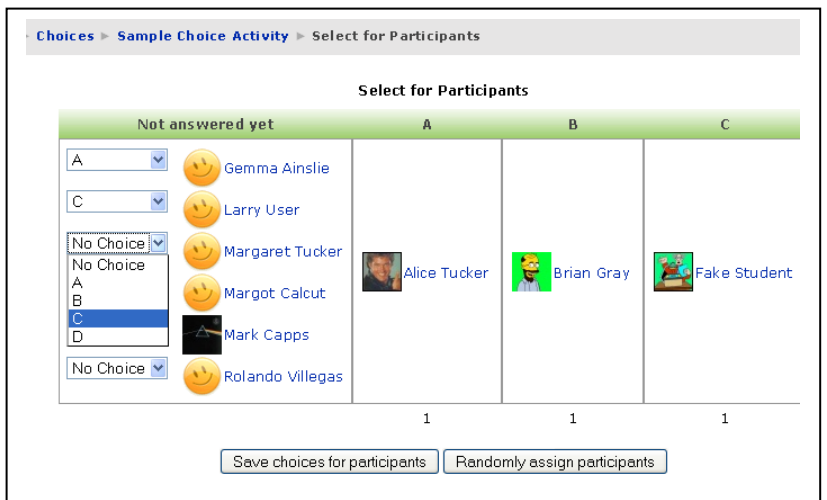


The screen shows all participants’ responses. Participants who have not responded have a **SELECT** box. Buttons at the bottom of the screen allow the teacher to save specific selected choices or randomly assign all participants without a response.

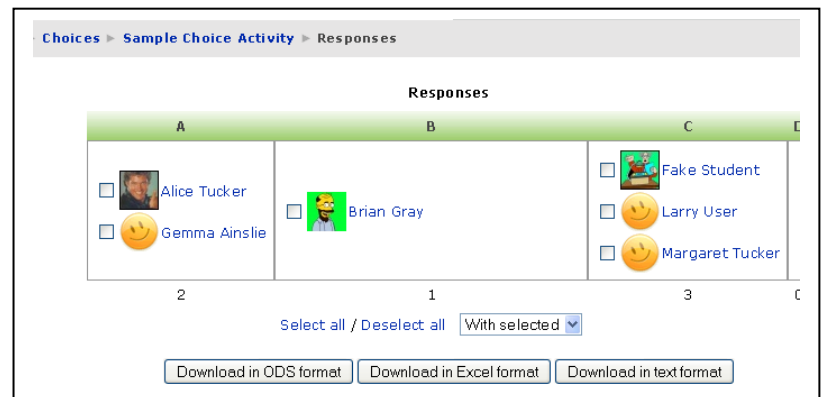
A link to the **View responses** screen appears on the **Select for participants** screen.



The teacher can select a choice option for any or all of the participants who have not responded, and then click **Save choices for participants.**



The selections are recorded and the screen is redisplayed.



In this screen, the Choice activity has limits enabled. Option C has a limit of 2 and has two participants already, so it does not appear in the SELECT list.

Option A has a limit of 3, with no participants assigned to it. The teacher is trying to assign 4 participants to Option A.

Participants are assigned to Option A until it is full. The rest are reported as an error.



All participant selections have been cleared, and limits have been changed. (There are 9 participants, but a total limit of only 8 slots.) The teacher chose the option to **Randomly assign participants**.

No assignments are made, and an error message is displayed.



Option limits have been adjusted, and participants have now been randomly assigned.
