

Wiki Issue: Cannot link to files in Subfolders of Course Files

Problem: In the Wiki Module, I am able to create a link to a file in the root of the Files folder, but not to files in Subfolders.

Example:

In the example below the link to “50 Excellent Personal Projects.docx” works fine; however, the link to “Supervision_Personal_Project.docx” does not.



