

Moodle Activity Completion Options

The Completion options/conditions for all activities are as follows:

Each Activity has 3 **Completion Options**:

1. Not Active
2. Set Manually (by student)
3. **Based on Conditions**

When **Based on Conditions** option is enabled, the following condition options are available:

Assignment, Lesson, Database, Quiz, Workshop, Scorm:

- View required
- Grade required

Chat & Wiki

- View required

Forum:

- View required
- Grade required
- Posts required - #
- Discussions required -#
- Replies required -#

Glossary:

- View required
- Grade required
- Entries required -#

Choice:

- Choice required

Note that the “Grade required” option does not specify an actual grade. This requires a separate setting in the gradebook, as shown here: <http://screencast.com/t/ZGx1Kce6>

Essentially, the proposed interface would provide all these options on one page, like this:

Notes about the interface:

- If the **Completion Tracking** setting = *Not set* or *Manual*, then the **Required Conditions** columns are empty and grey (inactive)
- If the **Completion Tracking** setting = *Conditions*, then the relevant options are displayed in the **Required Conditions** columns
- Show Activity Type dropdown menu allows user to view all types or just one (example: show all Forums)
- **Grade** column is set as a percentage. In addition to a set grade (example: 50%), the option “Any” grade may be selected (this is a standard Moodle option – not custom code)
- The “**with selected activities**” section allows user to set conditions for multiple activities at the same time (example: Set grade to 50% for all assignments in a course)
