

MDL-33559 Automatic zeros assigned in blank grade fields

Assignment

1. Turn on quick grading. Edit settings to allow feedback comments.
2. Give one student a grade and feedback.
3. Give another student comments but not a grade. (ie. This draft is not yet ready for a grade but needs teacher feedback.)
4. Leave one student blank in the grade and in the feedback and save changes.
