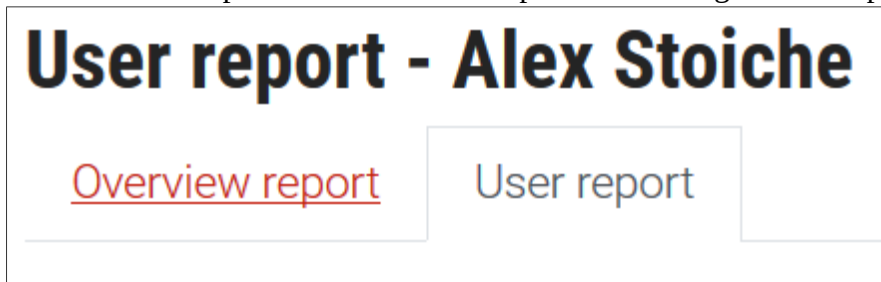


Example

Description

The elements used for overview and user reports have been implemented using tab behaviour, however the component has not been implemented using tab markup.

Implications

Screen reader users will not know that this is tabbed content and might miss out on content.

Recommendation

Provide the role 'tab' for the tab selectors and provide the attribute aria-selected="true" for the open tab.

Ensure the container element for the tabs have the role 'tablist' and any elements between the container and the tabs have a role of 'presentation'. Tabs have been implemented correctly in other components of the LMS (Tab style topics), it is recommended to use the existing functionality across this control.
